

Terms of Use

These Terms of Use govern your use of Daywell, operated by **Seth Raymond**.

Use of Daywell

Daywell helps parents and guardians organize chores, rewards, privileges, Stars, routines, streaks, Growth Points, and family activity.

You must be a parent, guardian, or authorized adult to create or manage a Daywell family account. You agree to enter only information you are authorized to manage.

Daywell is not a substitute for professional parenting, medical, legal, counseling, educational, or safety advice.

Accounts and Family Access

You are responsible for maintaining access to your account and keeping your sign-in information secure.

A Daywell family may include multiple parents when the family has an active household subscription. If a family has only an individual subscription, the subscribing parent may need to upgrade before inviting another parent.

Invitation links are intended only for the invited parent or guardian. You are responsible for sharing invitation links carefully.

Subscriptions

Daywell requires an active App Store subscription for continued access. Daywell offers individual and household subscription plans. Prices, free trials, introductory offers, billing terms, and renewal details are shown in the App Store purchase flow.

Subscriptions renew automatically unless canceled at least 24 hours before renewal. You can manage or cancel subscriptions in your Apple Account settings. Daywell cannot cancel App Store billing for you.

Introductory offers are controlled by Apple eligibility and may only be available to eligible new subscribers.

User Content

You keep responsibility for the family information you enter into Daywell. You give Daywell permission to store, process, sync, display, and back up that information as needed to operate the app.

You agree not to misuse Daywell, interfere with the service, attempt unauthorized access, upload unlawful content, or use the app in a way that harms others.

Account Deletion

You may request account deletion in the app. Deleting your Daywell account does not automatically cancel App Store billing. Subscription cancellation must be handled through Apple.

If other parents remain in a family account, shared family data may remain available to them. If the final parent deletes their account, the household is scheduled for deletion after the applicable deletion window.

Availability and Changes

Daywell may change, suspend, or discontinue features. The app depends on third-party services such as Firebase and Apple, and service interruptions may affect access or syncing.
